WHAT IS FAMILY PRESERVATION?

Stanford Sierra Youth & Families' Family Preservation program provides a "safetynet" for youth and their families who require specialized mental health and family support services. Trained clinicians provide individual, family, and group therapy, including comprehensive mental health services, with the goal of nurturing and strengthening families, so youth can remain safe and together with their families.

HOW TO MAKE A REFERRAL

You may request Stanford Sierra Youth & Families' Family Preservation services by contacting Nevada County's Access Team at (530) 470-2736. Access Team members provide information, assess service needs and eligibility criteria, authorize mental health services, and make referrals to contracted Stanford Sierra Youth & Families' mental health programs.
