WALKING THE JOURNEY WITH FAMILIES TO GET THEIR NEEDS MET



Stanford Sierra Youth & Families' Wraparound services wrap youth and families with comprehensive care to help keep children/youth safe and at home, in school, and thriving. Young people gain the support and guidance of our Wraparound services to help them remain at home or transition safely to a permanent family or healthy, independent living.

The program combines a family-centered, strengths-based, needs-driven, and team-driven approach with individualized and wellness-focused interventions. Our approach is comprehensive and outcome-driven utilizing creative and individualized strategies to address each family's needs. All Wraparound Programs are unified by standardized Wraparound principles and High Fidelity Wraparound practices.

PROGRAM FACTS:

- Stanford Sierra Youth & Families' has been leading positive permanency outcomes in Wraparound Services, since 2001. After participating in Wraparound services, most youth are living at home with their birth families, adoptive families, or kin/relatives.
- Youth and their families are eligible for Wraparound when youth are living in an out-of-home placement or at risk of living in an out-of-home placement. Youth and their families may be referred by Child Protective Services (CPS), the Department of Probation, Managed Care providers, or the Adoption Assistance Program (AAP).
- Wraparound encompasses working with the full family to address the needs identified in the CFT process.
- We achieve excellent outcomes for youth and their families through our use of High Fidelity Wraparound standards.
- Services are provided in families' homes, in community settings of families' choice, or in our conveniently located offices that have private family meeting rooms.
- Our Wraparound employees have been trained to understand the core issues of adoption and we explore families' unique culture and needs to develop a plan of action.
- Depending on the Wraparound Program services can last from 6-18 months dependent on youth/family needs.



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WHAT SERVICES LOOK LIKE:

- When youth and families are referred to our Wraparound program, they first meet with one of our professional staff for an Intake and Assessment meeting to determine the individualized needs for their family.
- Youth and families then develop a treatment plan with the support of our staff to identify goals and objectives.
- Professional staff are culturally competent, with services delivered with understanding and respect to each family's unique culture and put it at the forefront of our work together.
- Youth and families participate in Child Family Team (CFT) meetings regularly, as this is best practice and adherent to High Fidelity Wraparound.
- Families choose natural supports to participate in their Child and Family Team in addition to service providers and system partners.
- Child Family Team meetings are held in families' homes or at our conveniently located offices that have private family meeting rooms.
- Services include (but are not limited to):
 - Therapeutic Services (i.e. Individual or Family Therapy; Skill Building support for symptom management; Caregiver/Parent Support);
 - Support for Permanency Planning;
 - Independent Living Skills/Support;
 - Linkage to Community Resources;
 - Psychiatric/Medication Support Service Linkage;
 - Case Management to support with Treatment Plan; and
 - Coordination of Services.
